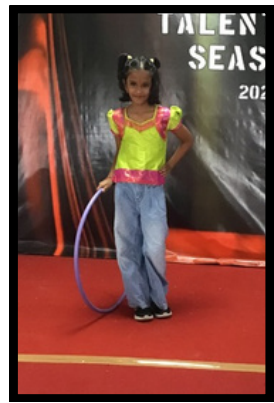
VIDYAARAMBHAM: A Joyous Beginning to the Journey of Learning

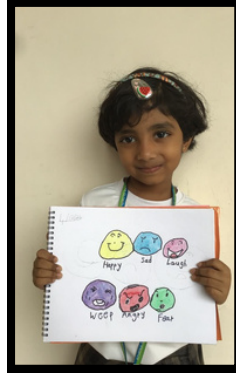


World's Millets Day
